School Language Policy

Welsh is the official language of y Login Fach. Welsh is the only medium of instruction in the Foundation Phase. Children become fluent in Welsh from a very young age. English is introduced into the curriculum as a subject in Year 3. Pupils are able to communicate freely orally and in writing in both English and Welsh by the time they leave school.

Provision of Toilet Facilities

The school has appropriate provision for the children enrolled in the school. The facilities are cleaned daily by the authority's cleaning department.

Pupil wellbeing is a key priority. We have 3 designated persons for safeguarding and all staff have been properly trained. The need has increased recently following the easing of restrictions and staff have been upskilled in providing effective support to individuals and groups at the school. 'Thrive' has been successfully implemented. We have established welfare groups within classes.

Attendance

Attendance- 90.3%

Mrs Rhian Davies and Mrs Delyth Hillman work closely with Rhiannon Smith our Education Welfare Officer from the Local Authority.

Some changes we have made to improve attendance data:

If your child needs to take medication, you don't need to keep them at home. We will administer the medication at school as long as you confirm consent. We have made every effort to keep HMS days close to the school holidays to keep holiday/travel costs down for you.

We arrange meetings with you if your child's attendance is low to provide support
